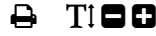


# Former Fairport Gas Station Transformed Into Brewery

Fairport Brewing Company is now on tap in downtown Fairport in a historic building.

Tim Garman is working hard on the minute touches to get this historic gas station in tasting room shape.

"Proud it's one hundred percent Fairport, one hundred New York; we are just excited," he said.

Garman, along with co-founder Paul Guarracini, have spend more than three months to move Fairport Brewing Company to its new home, smack dab in downtown Fairport.

"A lot of people have never been in here. It was an insurance company for 30 to 40 years. I think when they come in here they are going to see some character and enjoy some great beer," Garman said.

Six beers are on tap, including a special brew.

"Pure oil that's a tribute to this building right here; the pure oil building," he said. "We call it a malt bomb, so it's dark-like oil."

You can try some samples- a pint or take home a growler; and that bar- it was built from hand and etched by donors.

"We built the bar, New York State Lumber drove to Pulaski, New York for some hard rock maple," Garman said.

While it is still a work in progress, Fairport Brewing is now ready to provide that fill-up.

"It becomes a piece of history in Fairport and we are very proud of it," he said.
